

Baby Loss Awareness Campaign: General Information For Organising Your Own Wave of Light or Other Baby Loss Remembrance Service.



Thank you for your interest in organising a Wave of Light Service for Baby Loss Awareness¹

There are the following points to consider:

- What sort of service you want hold - whether completely secular (non-religious), ecumenical (non-denominational Christian) or another faith.
- Whether you want a celebrant (e.g. a hospital chaplain) to conduct the service.
- Venue - need a suitable space, with permission to light candles.

Once you have decided on what type of service to hold, we can help you with suggestions for suitable poems, readings and music to play as required. In addition we will help to publicise your event and can provide ribbon pins, posters, a press release and other advertising materials. If you have collecting tins at the service these should be clearly labelled so donors can easily identify who will benefit from the donations.
